PEF Education and Cost Saving Opportunities

Certification and License Renewal Fee Reimbursement (CLRFR) Program

- Provides reimbursement for the cost of examinations for first time certification, licensure, or designation
- Maximum reimbursement up to \$1,100 per calendar year, will not cover incomplete or failed exams

College Tuition Reimbursement (CTR) Program

- Provides reimbursement for job-related or career-related courses or Credit by Examination (CBE) exams that lead to college credit at an accredited college, university, or institution
- Maximum reimbursement up to \$5,000 (will not cover incomplete or failed courses)

Workshop and Seminar Reimbursement (WSR) Program

- Provides reimbursement for attendance at professional development courses, workshops, conferences, seminars, symposiums, and educational events given by approved providers and that do not result in college credit
- Maximum reimbursement up to \$1,600 per calendar year, requires successful completion of a course or event

Public Service Workshop Program (PSWP)

• Free Social Worker Continued Education Unit (CEU) workshops
