The Executive Budget recommends (analysis as of January 29, 2025):

- A FY 2025-26 workforce of 509, an increase of 18 from the 2024-25 Budget.
- The Department of Agriculture and Markets anticipates the loss of **20** positions through attrition and expects **69** new fills.

- A State Operations All Funds appropriation of **\$209,159,000**, an increase of **\$24,118,000** million (13%) from the enacted appropriation for the previous SFY.
- The total appropriation for Personal Services is **\$83,928,000**, an increase of **\$9,990,000** (13.5%) from the enacted appropriation for the previous FY.
- The agency employed an estimated 7.32 contract employees under consultant contracts in the previous FY at a cost of **\$1,026,753**. It is expected that the number consultant FTE contract employees and associate cost will **remain the same** in FY 2025-26. The cost for 7.32 contract employees is estimated to be \$1,026,753.
